- Dark colour trousers (***Strictly no jeans***)
- Enclosed shoes
- Please ensure you bring a black warm layer in case it is cold in the store

Waiter & Bartender

- Black long sleeved, collared shirt
- Black trousers or knee-length skirt (***Strictly no jeans***)
- Smart black shoes (no trainers)
- Black tie (***Optional depending on client*** – Specific information will be provided at the time of booking confirmation)
- Your hair must be tied up and out of your face, please remove all jewellery and nail varnish. Make-up must be kept to a minimum

Kitchen Porter, Cleaner or Housekeeper

- Black t-shirt
- Black trousers (***Strictly no jeans***)
- Safety shoes
- Your hair must be tied up and out of your face with a Chef Hat, please remove all jewellery.

Chef

- Full Chef Whites
- Chef trousers
- Safety shoes
- Your hair must be tied up and out of your face with a Chef Hat, please remove all jewellery.
